CHILDREN'S OFFERTORY ENVELOPES

The children's charity that will benefit from the offering in January is the local Hospice Camp Rainbow. The Camp is an overnight, weekend bereavement camp for children ages 5 to 12 who have experienced a loss or are currently living with a loved one with a terminal illness. The Camp is organized by Hospice Support Care, a non-profit, non-medical volunteer hospice support organization providing spiritual, practical, and emotional support to patients and their families. The primary goal of Camp Rainbow is to teach children how to grieve in a healthy manner, while building fond remembrances. LIVING STONES: THE LEGACY OF FAMILY NAMES

Running up the center of the proposed new courtyard, which will span from the front parking lot to the back, will be a "backbone" of "Living Stones," 18" x 18" granite paving stones, each featuring the last name of the family sponsoring it. It will be an historic record of the families whose generosity helped finish the parish renovations of 2008-2012.

The stones will cost us \$160 each, and we would like to ask \$500 per stone to help cover the costs of this final landscaping project, the paving of the entire, large courtyard. The courtyard will make walking from the back to the front of the property easier and safer. Please contact Fr. Rooney directly at the parish office soon if you are interested. Many stones have already been purchased. You may make installment payments. We need at least 100 stones for one complete row, front to back.
